

Key SystemsA Few Stay in Place All the Time

Because we run tests and demonstrations for you on a continuous basis, we keep several systems permanently assembled here at the Center.

1. FS-150 soft disposables reclaim system

for reject diapers, adult incontinence and hygienic products, bed pads and related items

2. BE 4242 Bale Eater system

for short fiber bales, scrap bales, reject product bales

3. Drum filter system

includes an Osprey design disc pre-filter and final filter


for testing all types of fiber and dust

4. Trim handling and collection

for short fiber bales, scrap bales, reject product bale

5. Edge trim collection and grinding for plastics, paper

In addition to these systems, we keep a number of separate components stocked at the Center. We use them to assemble the many variations on process air systems that you require from time to time.
