New BLUE-SKY Filter

Osprey's latest development is the Blue-Sky filter. Over two years of research and testing have gone into the Blue-Sky filter. Blue-Sky is built on the Osprey Phoenix filter platform. Big advantages of the Blue-Sky filter are that it does not require an Osprey Final Filter or a disk section. Additional benefits are HEPA quality filtration, lower initial equipment cost, reduced explosion risk and higher safety rating, and lower operating energy costs. New features included are Osprey's latest seal and media developments, new high capacity filter pockets, and an inlet pressure control loop.

Emission testing has proven the first stage drum filtration to be dramatically more efficient than the traditional Osprey filter.

This higher efficiency and a new second and third stage pocket design omit the need for self-cleaning cartridges. HEPA filters rated for an efficiency of 99.97% down to 0.3 micron are optional.

New Product Developments

In conjunction with the new Blue-Sky filter, Osprey has developed the new Ecogreen filter media and seal design that greatly reduces emissions for the Osprey drum filter section. As customers increase line speeds and SAP content, these new developments are vital to improve core forming, reduce waste, and reduce filter emissions.

New improved filter pockets for the Phoenix Composite Filter have been developed for a higher loading capacity and thus reduced filter replacement. An inlet pressure control loop is a new standard feature that monitors the vacuum level at the inlet of the drum filter, and adjusts the main fan speed to hold the inlet vacuum at the desired setpoint.
