Osprey's New Front Line Filter Available For Testing

The new Osprey Front Line filtration system is now available for testing at Osprey. The new filter design includes a Pre Filter Disk arrangement that can be used for quality fiber separation or as a bulk material receiver. The new system includes a five-stage filtra-

tion process including an Osprey Final Filter and HEPA filter section. The filter is complete with an

off-line collection system. Material collected at the collection station can either be bagged or baled.

According to

Marty Price, the new filter will allow for the testing of improved high velocity media, cartridge filters, and general testing applications. Osprey's newly developed Final Filter Sweep

System that automatically removes captured materials from the Final Filter section is to be added soon. The Front Line design has already been incorporated in our waste recycling systems thus omitting the need for other costly bulk material separators.

Osprey Offers Easier Cartridge Replacement

Osprey offers a Final Filter cartridge support yoke to ease the cartridge removal and reinstallation process when only one technician is available. The Installation is only a few minutes each. Once the yokes are installed a service technician only has to slide off the old cartridges and slide on the new.



yoke can be retrofitted to almost any Osprey Final Filter using one and a half (40") or double (52") cartridge configurations.

Each cartridge filter position is fitted with a yoke that inserts into the existing tube sheet mounting hole. A retaining ring with hardware finishes off each kit. All of the existing parts are reused. The great advantage of our arrangement over a conventional yoke is our shorter design allows the technician much more operating room when servicing the filters in an already confined area with limited working space.
